#### **Job Requirements:**

#### To be completed at time of employment

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Experienced in the care of children 0-4 years of age with the ability to adapt and interact with a variety of personalities/characteristics.
- Must have American Heart Association (AHA) or American Red Cross (ARC) CPR training/certification for infants and children, or be willing to complete a CPR course at Prayer of Faith's expense.
- Planned absences must be given at least one week ahead of time.
- In the case of last-minute illness, he or she must contact Pastor Eric Ferguson by phone at least 2 hours prior to his or her shift so a replacement or volunteer may be found.
- Dependability is essential. Tardiness and excessive unscheduled absences may result in termination of employment.
  - There will be a six-month probationary period where either party may, with a two-week notice, terminate employment without cause.
  - Immediate termination will occur in cases of intentional verbal, physical or emotional abuse or neglect of any child, parent or church member.
  - Nursery workers will be terminated if they fail to follow nursery policies listed above or in situations of absence or habitual lateness.

#### **Service Expectations:**

- · Arrive at least 5 minutes before scheduled service time.
- Pray! Pray! Pray! Pray individually for children as they play, as they listen to the story, and for the other caregivers as you work together.
- Every child's diaper should be changed before parent's pick up. Potty training children should 'try' at least once.
- Oversee the check-in process. All children should have name stickers on their individual items, cups and bags if parents bring them. Parents will need to check-in their child using the sign in form (or whatever process you choose to use).
- Oversee the check-out process. Parents will need to check-out their child using the sign out form (or whatever process you choose to use).
- Clean and straighten the room after the children leave, including the restroom.
- On Wednesday evenings, if no children show up at 7:15 p.m., you may have the option to leave, and still will be paid for the full hour.
- On special events, such as Sunday dinner fellowships (Chili Cookoff January, Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and other ministry events that Prayer of Faith conducts) you will have the option to work additional hours if you choose, at the same pay rate.

#### **Interacting With Parents:**

- Always thank the parent for bringing their child. It is our privilege to serve them
- Always smile (even when you are tired)
- Always tell the parents about any diaper or feeding events, also any cute or happy events
- If there is a direct concern about a child, please notify one of the pastors immediately.

#### **Teaching Little Ones:**

- We allow you the freedom to choose age appropriate teaching material for your Nursery Work Ministry. Whichever one you choose, please show
   Pastor Eric Ferguson the material just so he will be informed should any of the parents inquire.
- Any materials or supplies you need for the nursery, please let Pastor Eric Ferguson know beforehand so that he may get you your appropriate material, or if you wish to purchase it and be reimbursed, you may do so.
- Integrate the biblical truth or theme into the activities the children are doing. Take advantage of every opportunity to make the truths "real" to the children, repeating them over and over, applying them to anything normal around them.
  - Example: "Do you see the elephant in the puzzle? God made elephants. What else did God make? God made everything!"
- Your role is to teach the children a short Bible lesson each week, if possible. It is important to be able to express excitement, energy, and love for God's word when sharing the story and its principle. It is to be taught as truth, not as just a story.
